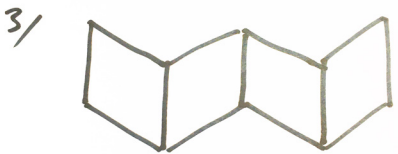
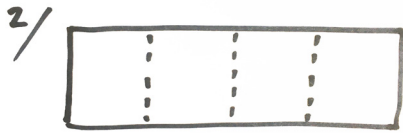
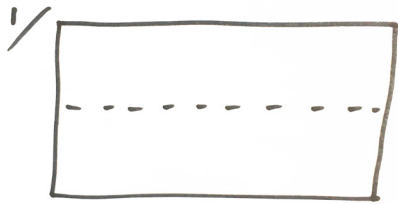


Fantastical worlds and where to find them
